I will help my teammates whenever possible because I know this is a TEAM game and we will improve more individually if we can improve together.

_____ I will be respectful and show good sportsmanship on and off the ice of all individuals on this team, coaches, my opponents, officials, and spectators. I will not use profane, derogatory, or otherwise hurtful language or actions at any time on or off the ice.

_____ I will be respectful of the facilities that I participate at. I will leave the facility as clean or cleaner than I left it and I will make sure my teammates do the same. I will not write on the walls, leave trash laying around, or otherwise cause damage to the facility. If found to have intentionally trashed or damaged facility property, I will be held responsible.

_____ I will arrive to practices and games at the designated times requested by team staff and will be adequately prepared to play. I will be a good teammate by being prepared and playing in a manner that is appropriate.

_____ I will learn the value of commitment and team work by participating in as many practices and games as I can.

_____ If I have a question or concern, I will respectfully request to address it with coaching staff. If I do not feel comfortable, I know I/my guardians have the right to bring my concern to the director of hockey for the association.
